

Exhibit 4 - Fugitive Dust Suppression Plan

ConocoPhillips Company Rush South Oil & Gas Well

In addition to complying with COGCC Rule 805.c in regards to Fugitive Dust, ConocoPhillips Company will mitigate such emissions resulting from grading activities and/or wind by using reasonably available control technology as defined by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.

ConocoPhillips Company shall maintain the dust free surface as provided within the site plan. Otherwise if ConocoPhillips Company fails to maintain the dust free surface as identified within the site plan and fails to correct the condition after notification of the condition, ConocoPhillips Company agrees to remove it and replace it with an improved surface such as concrete or asphalt within the specified time of the notification.

During construction activities, sprinkling with a water truck will be utilized to mitigate dust. The Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP) Best Management Practices (BMPs) administer erosion control measures, which inherently is a dust control measure.
